Name:

CONPARMUSA Scholarship Award

Amount and Frequency:

- Lump Sum, one time basis.
- Amount will vary based on funding, usually between \$500-\$1,000.
- 1-5 scholarships will be issued.
- Payment will be made pending proof of payment to college or class schedule.

USE:

- The scholarship is to be used solely for tuition or school expenses at any accredited two/four-year college or university.
- The recipient will not receive any other additional financial support from CONPARMUSA beyond the one-time scholarship award.

Recipient:

- Student who is a graduating senior from High School and has been accepted at an accredited two or four-year college/university.
- The student should have at least one parent of Paraguayan-American heritage.
- Household income for candidate should not exceed \$90,000 annually.

Selection Process:

 The selection will be made by a committee which will be managed by the CONPARMUSA Board of Directors.

Criteria for Selection:

- Ranking: GPA (Grade Point Average).
- Participation in extracurricular activities.
- Essay responses showing intellectual curiosity and capacity of learning.
- SAT or ACT Scores.
- Overall Score.
